Dear Parent/Guardian:

Beginning in the 2019-20 school year, North Collins Junior-Senior High School will be transitioning to a paperless report card system for all students, grades 7 through 12. Report cards will no longer be mailed home; instead, parents will be able to access and review their child's report card online via the district's PowerSchool Parent Portal. The shift to a paperless reporting system began this past school year with communications like this one, which included directions for the Parent Portal and reminders.

For most of you, this will be a seamless transition as grade reporting for students at all levels have been available on the parent portal for many years. The Parent Portal has provided parents and students an option to view grades, assignments and attendance online even before printed copies were sent home. We are hopeful the shift saves money in terms of printing and postage, but more importantly it provides real-time, online access for student grades as they are recorded by teachers. Parents no longer need to worry about missing or misplacing their child's report card as all of the information will be available on their individual parent portal account throughout the year. In addition to housing student report cards, the district's PowerSchool Parent Portal provides parents with detailed access to student attendance, assignments, grades, and scheduling. This shift will continue to allow parents the ability to stay informed about their child's educational program. If you have not yet created a Parent and Student Portal account, please be sure to do so.
